Eight Ways to Fight Colds and Flu

Did you know?

Did you know that you can reset a timesheet in BST even if you have already signed? If you submit a signed timecard, and it has not yet been approved by your supervisor, then realize a change is needed, you can un-sign it by clicking the reset button on the menu bar in BST (pictured to the right). Then simply edit your timesheet and re-sign when finished.





Did you know you can clear your employee record from being marked "Out-of-office"? If you've been checked "out-of-office" for any reason, you can also check yourself back in at any time by clicking on the OOO button on the menu tool bar in BST (pictured to the left). Simply uncheck the "out-of-office" box on the pop-up screen, hit "ok," and you should be good to go.

Professional Courtesy

Enviro Clean's workplace culture provides both job flexibility and work-life balance. Several employees are afforded the opportunity to work from home, select their own work hours, work at different locations as needed, and take time off to attend classes or other personal events. For many office staff members, the general attitude is that if you are getting your work done you can set your own 40-hour workweek.

Unfortunately, job flexibility can leave gaps in communication. Not having your work hours micro managed is great, but as a common courtesy, employees should keep others informed about their work schedule. While you and your supervisor will be the keeper of your work schedule, there are just some basic workplace protocols that go without saying. Here's saying them:

- I) Don't have your supervisor or team members guess your whereabouts. Always let someone know where you are if you are coming in late, visiting another location, meeting a client or vendor, leaving early, attending classes, etc.
- 2) If you can or need to work from home, notify your supervisor that you will be staying home to work. Better yet, if you don't generally work from home, get your supervisor's approval.
- 3) Vacation days should be approved in advance. Occasionally, incidents happen where you may unexpectantly need a day off. Contact your supervisor to let him/her know of your intentions.
- 4) If you take a longer lunch or need to run an errand be sure to tell your supervisor or a co-worker (generally the administrative coordinator at your office). This will let your co-workers know you plan on returning for the day.

 5) Everyone does not work the same 2:00cm to 5:00cm schedule. Be sure you maintain the same or close to the same daily work schedule.
 - 5) Everyone does not work the same 8:00am to 5:00pm schedule. Be sure you maintain the same or close to the same daily work schedule.

 This will help with locating you when customers or employees call.

401(k) Class 101

Are you contributing to Enviro Clean's 401(k) plan? No?! I guess you don't like free money. Before I go there, let's just discuss the basic benefits of contributing to a 401(k) plan.

- Tax Advantages Your traditional 401(k) contribution allows you to contribute a certain percentage of your income on a pretax basis. The amount you contribute to your 401(k) is exempt from current federal income tax, so it lowers your taxable income. Additionally, your earnings accrue on a tax deferred basis. You don't pay taxes on the dividends or gains until you begin withdrawing from the plan. Enviro Clean also has a Roth 401(k) option. Your Roth 401(k) contributions are made with after-tax dollars, but future withdrawals are fully tax-free if certain conditions are met.
- Contribution Amounts For 2018 you can contribute up to \$18,500 per year. The plan also allows for "catch-up" contributions, which allow savers 50 or older to contribute up to \$24,500 per year
- Show me the money One of the biggest benefits of a 401(k) is the employer match. This is basically free money given to you for contributing to the plan. Not only does Enviro Clean match up to ½ of your contribution for a maximum match of 3%, but all match funds are vested immediately!!!!

Remember – Odds are you will grow old. You will eventually retire. You will need money. Contributing to your 401(k) plan can help with at least two out of three. Isn't that a Meatloaf song?!

6) If you are not coming to work at all due to illness or other personal reasons, but sure to call your supervisor. Believe it or not, your co-workers care and worry about you.

Following the above simple rules helps to keep the workplace running smoothly and efficient.

Remember - Common courtesy is just a respectful way to be considerate of others. It's no big deal that's why it's called common.
